BOND 2018 VOTER INFORMATION

DATE, TIME AND LOCATION

Date: Tuesday, May 15, 2018*

Time: 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

**Locations: Dryden Street School, Park Avenue School,
Drexel Avenue School and Westbury Middle School**

** Please note: The 2018 Bond Referendum vote will take place on the same day, same times and in the same locations as the District's annual budget vote and Board member elections.*

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be a resident of the Westbury School District for at least 30 days preceding the vote.
- Must be at least 18 years old as of May 15, 2018.
- Must be registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections to vote in general elections OR be registered with the Westbury School District, or have voted in a school election within the past four years.

For those not already registered, registration for the May 15, 2018 Bond Referendum will take place on Tuesday, May 8, 2018, from 2:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. at Dryden Street School, Drexel Avenue School, Park Avenue School and Westbury Middle School.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

You must first obtain and submit an application for your absentee ballot; after it is received and processed by the district clerk, you will be issued an absentee ballot.

Anyone who is eligible to vote and is either incapacitated or will not be in Westbury for the vote on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, may request an application for an absentee ballot by calling the district clerk's office at 516-874-1828.

If the voter wants to receive the absentee ballot by mail, the completed application must be returned to the district clerk seven days before the vote—Tuesday, May 8, 2018. If the completed application is delivered to the district clerk in person, it must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day before the vote—Monday, May 14, 2018.

All absentee ballots must be delivered to the district clerk's office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the vote—Tuesday, May 15, 2018.
